How to Fill Out the United States Census

- Go online to https://my2020census.gov/ or complete it over the phone by calling 844-330-2020
- The Census is available online in 15 languages.
- The Census counts all residents, regardless of citizenship or immigration status—therefore, the Census does not include a citizenship question.
- Even if you are undocumented, filling out the Census will not put you or your family at risk.
- Census responses are private, protected by federal law, kept strictly confidential, and can
 never be used against you by a court, government agency, law enforcement authorities, or
 third parties like a business or your landlord.

Please take your time when reading the rest of the iNotes as there is a lot of important information.
